

WNMD GIRLS MINISTRIES SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

PURPOSE:

To offer a scholarship to Girls Ministries Bronze, Silver and/or Gold Medals of Honor recipients who have applied the principles learned in Mpack and Teen Girl Ministries to their lives and:

- Excel in academics
- Participate in extra-curricular activities
- Are involved in local church ministry and outreach
- Involved in community service

SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship amount will be \$500. One or more scholarships may be awarded each year as funding allows.

ELIGIBILITY

Application for the Girls Ministries Scholarship should be submitted to the WNMD Girls Ministries Director. The applicant must have been involved in Mpack and/or Teen Girl Ministries in the WNMD District. The applicant must apply as a high school senior and must be postmarked no later than March 31st. If awarded, the scholarship will be sent directly to the college/university/technical school, of your choice, to be used the fall following your high school graduation.

GIRLS MINISTRIES SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This scholarship is in the amount of \$500. The scholarship money will be sent directly to the college/university/technical school of the student's choice.

To apply for the Girls Ministries Scholarship, you must be in your **SENIOR** year of high school, currently involved in a WNMD Girls Ministries **CHARTERED** church, and you must be a Bronze, Silver, and/or Gold Metal of Honor Recipient. 1. Please send a high school transcript with GPA included.
2. Include a Girls Ministries Sponsor's recommendation – this should be about 100 – 150 words.
3. Include a Youth pastor/youth leader or Senior Pastor's recommendation – this should be approximately 100 – 150 words.
4. Type an essay which includes how long you have been involved in Girls Ministries, what level of achievement you have completed (with documentation), and what M'pact and/or Teen Girl Ministries has meant to you. This essay should be between 200 – 300 words. Include a paragraph describing your future goals.

A scholarship committee will evaluate each part of the application sent in and the recipient will be notified following graduation.

MINISTRY & OUTREACH PARTICIPATION

- ♥ Ministry participation would be any Christ-centered outreach in which the main goal and volume of time was spent ministering to others. This would include any type of gospel presentation (preaching, teaching, choir performance, etc.) or ministry listed in the Gospels (feeding, clothing, medical outreach, prison or shut-in visitation, distribution of literature, etc.) This category **does not** include competition-related performances (such as Fine Arts Festival) which should be listed under extra-curricular activities. However, actual outreach-related performances of music or speaking based on Fine Arts material would be listed in this section. Examples of ministry activities might include volunteering, planning, teaching, performing, or administrating at: vacation bible school, Sunday school, youth services, children’s church or nursery workers, involvement in AIM activities, camp counselor, public performances and outreaches, or health facilities.

- ♥ Level of participation could be: volunteer, teacher/tutor, supervisor, planner, administrator, etc.
